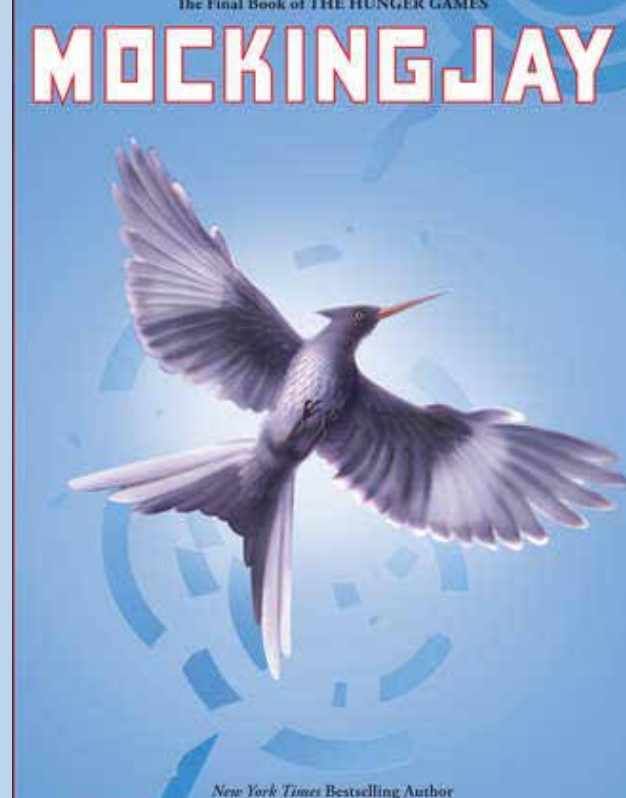
CATCHING FIRE

"My name is Katniss Everdeen. Why am I not dead? I should be dead."

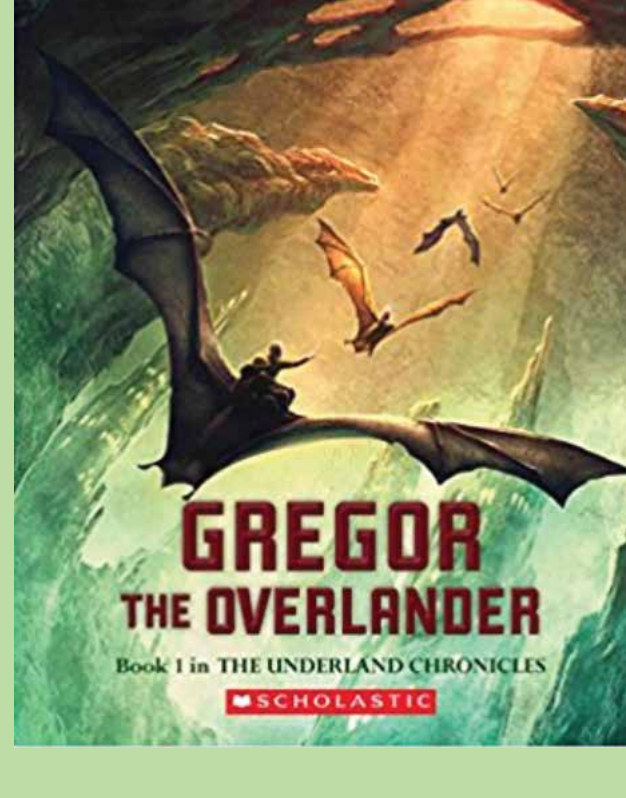
Katniss Everdeen has survived, even though her home has been destroyed. There are rebels. There are new leaders. A revolution is unfolding.

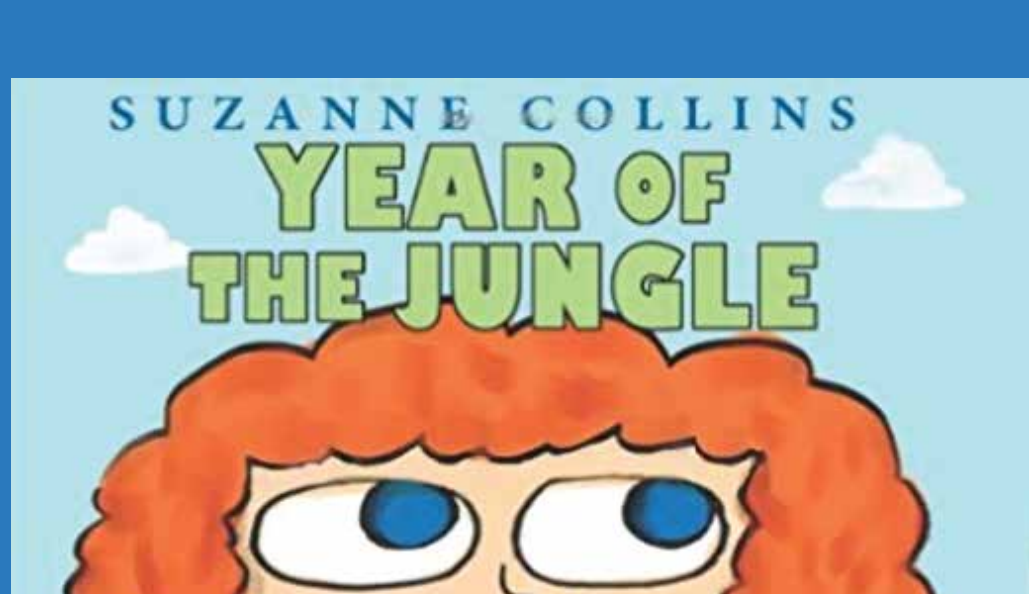
Year of the Jungle
